INSTALLING VARICAM PURE FIRMWARE VERSION 7.50 AND VIEWFINDER FIRMWARE VERSION 1.10

1. Downloading the software from the Codex website

Codex software is available from <https://codex.online/software>

To access this page of the website you must first register for an account.

The download is a zip that contains VariCam Pure (AU-VCXRAW2) firmware v7.5 and Viewfinder (AU-VCVF1) firmware version v1.1. Inside this are two further zip files for the firmwares, that need to be unzipped so that a 'private' folder is shown. This is the folder that should be copied to the SD card for installation.

2. Change Notes

VariCam Pure v7.5 has the following changes since v7.1:

- Anamorphic desqueeze can be applied to the playback image. (SYSTEM SETTINGS -> ANAMORPHIC DESQUEEZE -> MON OUT / VF & VF SDI)
- MON out signal now includes RDD18 packets for metadata, including CLIP name.
- INFRA mode for wireless connection, allowing connection to wireless access points. (PERIPHERAL -> WIRELESS PROPERTY -> TYPE)
- Playback Grading feature, giving the option to apply CDL/3D LUT to the playback image. (SYSTEM SETTINGS -> COLOR SETTINGS -> PLAYBACK GRADING)
- HIGH SPEED modes now allow frame rates down to 1fps. NOTE: VFR cannot be turned off in HIGH SPEED mode, so audio is always disabled (even if frame rate matches system frequency).

Viewfinder firmware v1.1 comes included as a recommended update.

3. Installation of VariCam Pure firmware

1. Ensure the camera is running and check INFO->VERSION. If the version listed is 7.10 or lower then the update can be performed. (The update process will not attempt to re-install or downgrade if the same or higher version is already loaded).
2. Format an SD card in the VariCam Pure SD card slot, using - MENU->SYSTEM SETTINGS->CARDS/MEDIA->FORMAT CARD->SD CARD.
3. Unzip the downloaded file on your computer, and copy the folder called 'private' to the top level of the SD card.
4. Start with the VariCam Pure powered down.
5. Disconnect the Control Panel and insert the SD card into the VariCam Pure.
6. Reconnect the Control Panel.
7. Connect power to the VariCam Pure and press the power button to start the system.
8. Press INFO->VERSION, then press the centre of the Jog Dial followed by UPDATE.
9. If there is a version mismatch between the AU-V35C1 (camera head) and AU-VCXRAW2 (recorder), a message will be displayed, with a prompt allowing you to run the upgrade from SD card.
10. The update will commence, and you will be prompted to power down the VariCam Pure when the update is complete.
11. If the power button does not shut down the camera, remove the main power cable from the AU-VCXRAW2 to shut down.

4. Installation of Viewfinder firmware

Repeat the installation steps from section 3, but this time copy the 'private' folder for the Viewfinder firmware to the SD card.
